


Light of the World Retreat February 16-19, 2024

Every year, we have a **Light of the World Retreat** designed to help people rediscover, re-engage, and deepen their Catholic faith. For over 20 years, this retreat format has been used around the country and has dramatically improved the spiritual lives of thousands of people, many of them in our own community. If you have not attended this retreat, I encourage you to attend this one. Whether you have or haven't, I highly encourage you to think of someone who could use a spiritual kickstart and personally invite them to register for this one.

It will begin on Friday evening, February 16th on the Church campus. It fills most of the day Saturday and Sunday (Mass included) and has a single follow-up session on Monday evening, February 19th.

Food and materials are provided, though we recommend bringing a comfortable chair. There is no cost to attend. Forms can be found in the back of Church and at the parish office.


Word of God Marathon Jan 17-21
