

Thoughts and updates from Fr. Albert

As many of you know, we are in the midst of a national Eucharistic Revival. It's a multiyear, national effort to increase belief in and devotion to the Eucharist. Please visit <u>eucharistic revival.org</u> to find out more. The first year of the process - the diocesan phase - is wrapping up and was focused mainly on preparing the diocese for various initiatives. Next weekend, June 11, is the **Solemnity of Corpus Christi** (Latin for "the Body of Christ"), marks the beginning of the parish year of revival. Parishes around the diocese will using various initiatives to strengthen Eucharistic faith and devotion in their own communities. So, I'd like to mention some of the things we'll be doing.



To start off, we will have a **Eucharistic Procession next Sunday** (June 11) after the 9am Mass. We usually do this on the Solemnity of Christ the King, where we go through the cemetery to pray for faithful departed. Next week, however, we will make a loop around the field beside the church as a way of consecrating the whole property to Eucharistic devotion. Then, throughout the year, we'll continue to weave Eucharistic themes into our various programs and small groups. We also plan to offer a small group study dedicated specifically to the Eucharist.

For the parish year, the diocese is publishing a "Eucharistic Passport," that feature most of the adoration chapels in the diocese. The idea is that you can make a miniature pilgrimage to the various chapels, where you can the stamp your passport and spend some time praying for revival in the parish and diocese. The diocese is also planning to host a **Eucharistic Rally on October 5th at the Cajundome Convention Center.** Dr. Ralph Martin will be the keynote speaker. We hope to have people from across the diocese come together for the Eucharist that unites us all together.

At the end of the parish year, we will transition into the Year of National Revival where the focus will be on connecting all the small communities and efforts into a nation-wide growth in Eucharistic Faith. The highlight of that year is the **National Eucharistic Congress**, taking place **July 17-21, 2024** in **Indianapolis, IN**. Organizers are hoping for as many as 80,000 Catholics from around the country to come together in celebration of the profound gift that Jesus has given us in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Each day will take a theme from Salvation History and the life of Jesus, offering talks, devotions, and events that tie that theme into the sacramental life.

I personally plan to attend the whole event. If you're interested, you can find out more at eucharisticcongress.org. You can buy tickets through the site and they'll send you information on booking hotels. The diocese does have a limited number of discounted adult tickets

available on a first come, first served basis. Please speak with me if you're interested in those.

Whatever you do, please pray for this effort. A true Revival is not something we do ourselves, but a response to the Holy Spirit. We believe it was the Spirit's inspiration that moved the bishops to make this effort. Our part is to respond with faith to our shepherds and to the Holy Spirit. Nurture your own faith in the Eucharist with study and meditation! Give witness to the Eucharist with greater reverence and devotion at Mass and in the chapel! And above all, pray! Pray with gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist. Pray with generosity in uniting yourself to the sacrifice of the Mass. Pray with confidence that the God who gave us the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of his own Son will not withhold from us anything that is truly to our benefit. May God bless our parish, diocese, and nation!
